

Tejas prayer walking map

Directions:

1. Start at one of the designated locations below. Ask the Lord to help you focus your heart on Him.
2. Look at the prayer focus and if time allows, read the different scriptures to pray through concerning that area. Take note of the prayer points.
3. Spend a few minutes praying out loud together in that location; then begin to walk and continue to pray until you reach the next destination on the map. You may pray out loud or silently as you walk.
4. You should either be praying or looking through the scriptures through out the whole prayer walk. If you are with other people, then do not talk about other topics or get distracted.
5. Stay focused until you reach your final destination (Hebrews 12:2). Be diligent as there is great power in prayer.
