

## Sharing Jesus without Fear

Most Christians hold back on telling others of the saving grace that is found in Jesus Christ. The reason for this is fear, and it is not from God. Satan uses fear to stop the grace of God from spreading. As Christians we are called to daily live as a light to others in all that we do. We put our trust in the LORD to work through us as we share the gospel of God's grace.

*"Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit."  
Matthew 28:18-19*

*Key Principle to Remember: God does the work. We cannot fail. It is all God's work.*

### Truths about evangelism:

*"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast." Ephesians 2:8-9*

*"I came to you in weakness and fear, and with much trembling. My message and my preaching were not with wise and persuasive words, but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power."*

**1 Corinthians 9:3-4**

*"No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him, and I will raise him up at the last day."*

**John 6:45**

*"This is why I told you that no one can come to me unless the Father has enabled him." John 6:65*

*"We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making His appeal through us."*

**2 Corinthians 5:20**

*"So is my word that goes out from my mouth: it will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it." Isaiah 55:11*

### How to Evangelize:

#### **I. Use questions that determine where God is working:**

- Do you have any kind of spiritual belief?
- Who is Jesus?
- Do you believe there is a heaven or a hell?
- If you died right now, where would you go? If heaven, why?
- If what you believe were not true, would you want to know it?

If they answer yes, open your Bible to let God's word speak to his/her heart.

If they answer no, ask him/her if you may pray for him/her.

## 2. Let the Bible speak

Read the following verses out loud and ask him/her what the verse is saying to him/her.

- Romans 3:23
- Romans 6:23
- John 3:3 “You must be born again.” Ask why did Jesus come to die?
- John 14:6
- Romans 10:9-11
- Romans 10:13

## 3. Close with Key Questions

- Are you a sinner?
- Do you want forgiveness for your sins?
- Do you believe Jesus died on the cross for your sins and rose again?
- Are you willing to surrender your life to Christ?
- Are you ready to invite Jesus into your life and your heart as your LORD and Savior?

## 4. Be silent and pray

Heavenly Father, I have sinned against You. I need to be cleansed and forgiven for all my sins. I believe that your Son, Jesus Christ, died on the cross for my sins and rose again. Father I give you my life to do as you wish; I want Jesus to come into my heart and become ruler of my life. In Jesus' name, Amen.
