

# Evening Recreation Summer 2009

The Tejas Rec Team is available to lead your evening activities upon your request. Below is a list and description of the evening activities that we can provide.

## **Tejas Games**

Tejas Games starts when each team is given a clue that leads them to a location around the camp. At each location Tejas Staff will lead two teams in a creative competition. After a signal is given groups receive a new clue that leads them to their next activity. There are usually about 6 rotations and the entire game lasts about an hour. The maximum number of campers able to play Tejas Games at one time is 250.



## **Mud Pit**

Our mud games are sure to bring a new meaning to the idea of playing in the mud. The old Camp Tejas Rodeo Arena is turned into a huge mud pit after being soaked with water. Then campers compete against other teams in fast, fun relays either to gain points or just to have fun in the mud. Everyone participating must be washed off at the arena by the Tejas Staff prior to showering or any other activity. The maximum number of campers that can participate in the mud games at one time is 250.

## **Hayride & Campfire**

The stars at night are big and bright deep in the heart of Texas, and deep in the heart of Camp Tejas! While at the camp, experience the countryside first hand on a real hayride and at a roaring campfire. There are two locations for your campfire: about a 15 minute ride to the meadows amphitheater or the amphitheater at the bottom of the prayer trail. We can take the campers on a hayride and then to either campfire area. The passenger limit on the hayrides is 100 people. We can make multiple trips and roasting skewers can be provided.

## **Pool Party**

Many groups enjoy spending an evening down at our exciting pool. With a lazy river, 106 ft. long figure eight tube slide, diving area, and recreation area, the pool is ready for any party you can throw at it. You are welcome to use it as it is or we can provide music to add to the atmosphere. The maximum capacity at the pool is 250 at one time. NOTE: Groups using the Meadows Retreat Center will have access to the pool the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> evenings of camp. Groups using Camp Tejas will have access to the pool every 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> evenings of camp. These guidelines are flexible if changes are discussed before May 1.

**Campwide** – Everything begins when teams are given a long list of questions. Then they must go around as a group to find the answers to the questions. Some are obvious, like “what 3 colors are on the gym floor” and others will be challenging, like “find a staff member near the tennis court to help you find out which building is the oldest on the property”. After about an hour groups meet back to see who has the most points.

## **Counselor Hunt**

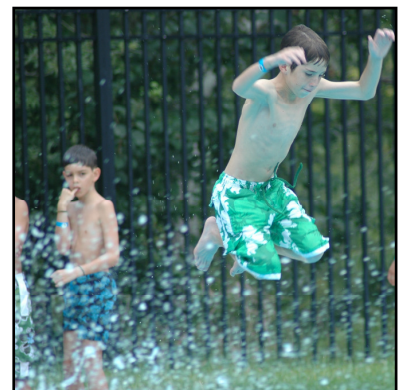
In this more intense version of Hide and Go Seek, our staff and possibly your sponsors race to try to find hiding places around the camp where the campers are challenged to find them. Each counselor is worth a number of points that can be awarded to teams. For a more exciting version, campers can throw the found counselors into the supervised lake.

## **Camper Hunt**

Many campers think they know the best hiding places at Tejas, let's test their abilities. The same as a counselor hunt but let the campers hide and we will attempt to find them.

## **Evening Wall and Zip**

Enjoy the Climbing and Zip tower during the day? Come try it at night. The wall and zip will be lit up, but climbing and zipping in the dark adds a new level of adventure to everything.



### **Old School Relays**

Very similar to the mud pit relays but without all the mess and mud. Come and let the campers run and compete against all their friends in these fun relay races.

### **Capture the Flag**

Camo up and hunker down. This classic game is a bunch of fun in the darkness of Tejas.

### **Evening Rec Rotations**

Similar to the morning Rec rotations, but these happen in the dark. This multi-day event will keep all your campers occupied for multiple nights in a row.
